NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a general election for the selection of Mayor and all five members of the Woodland City Council shall be held on November 4, 2025, at the regular time and under the procedures set forth herein. Polls will open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-403

The term of these offices shall be from January 1, 2026 until December 31, 2029.

Each candidate for the election shall be a qualified voter under the Constitution and laws of the State of Georgia and the Charter & Ordinances of the City of Woodland for twelve (12) months prior to the date of the election and shall be a resident of the City of Woodland at the time of qualification.

The first day to qualify for this election is Monday, August 18, 2025; and the last day to qualify is Friday, August 22, 2025. Qualifying shall take place at the City Hall location (49 East Main Street, Woodland, GA) during the following hours: *Monday*, August 18th, from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M; *Tuesday*, August 19th, from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M; *Wednesday*, August 20th, from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M; *Thursday*, August 19th, from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 PM; and *Friday*, August 20th, from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. The qualifying fee for the Mayor seat is \$108.00, and the qualifying fee for a Council seat is \$36.00.

Early voting begins on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, thru Friday, October 31, 2025.

The last day to register to vote in this election will be on Monday, October 6, 2025. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-224(a)

Voter registration can be completed at the Elections Office in Talbotton, Georgia, on the Georgia Secretary of State's website at sos.ga.gov under the "Elections" tab, or through the Georgia Department of Driver Services' license voter registration.
